Psalm 84 (ESV)

- ¹ How lovely is your dwelling place, O LORD of hosts!
- ² My soul longs, yes, faints for the courts of the LORD; my heart and flesh sing for joy to the living God.
- ³ Even the sparrow finds a home and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may lay her young at your altars, O LORD of hosts, my King and my God.
